

Visitation Expectations

The following is now effective at Skaalen, please see the new guidelines for visiting information at Skaalen:

Masks will no longer be required for visitors and staff. Masks will be available if it is the preference of a visitor, staff, or resident to wear. Masking may have to resume for visitors and staff under the following conditions:

- There is a COVID-19 outbreak or other respiratory outbreak in the facility.
- Staff who have been screened for a mild illness and must wear a mask for the duration of their illness.
- Increased community incidence of COVID-19 evidenced by: county COVID-19 hospital admission levels increase and when mask use is recommended in the community.
- Facility discretion for other reasons.

- ✓ Visitors and staff will still be required to screen in. Visitors, please screen in at the front desk upon entering the facility.
- ✓ There will be signs at the front desk and in designated areas indicating whether or not it is necessary to wear a mask at that time. Please abide by the direction of this sign when visiting.
- ✓ If you are feeling ill or have recently been exposed to someone with COVID-19, we kindly ask that you postpone your visit until a later time.
- ✓ If you have any questions, please see the front desk to be directed to someone for more information.
